Nouraie and Josh Richardson, who join as partners, and Lynn
Beckemeier, who joins as of counsel. Nouraie and Lynn
Beckemeier also had been at The Beckemeier Law Firm.
Richardson was at McMahon Berger.

The practice will include business law, civil litigation, labor and employment, real estate, nonprofit counsel, estate planning and probate, religious freedom and expression, and international law.
